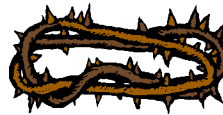

PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

As we progress through the transition of the coming months, please, put the following dates on your calendar. September 20th and October, 25th. These will be opportunities for you to express your opinion of WHERE WE ARE and WHERE YOU THINK GOD IS CALLING THIS CONGREGATION to serve the congregation, community and the world.

On September 20th we will have our normal worship time through the Offertory part of the service. Then we will do some group participation followed by a questionnaire that I will be examining and compiling for a report to you. Then we will close with some singing and prayer.

October 25th the Rev. Dr. Beth Dobbins will lead our worship service. Then we will have a brunch break for everyone. Following the brunch we will return to the sanctuary for a visioning session. This will be the time to determine where you feel this congregation is being called by God to best serve in the next five to ten years.

These are some of the most important things to be accomplished during this transition. First we will establish who and where we are, right now, not five years ago nor in the future. This is imperative to recognize the base that we have to build upon. Second, we will brainstorm where and what we feel God is calling us to be over the next period of this congregation's life. We do this for several reasons, all ideas are considered, it will give us a purpose for the future and it will give the Search Committee the guidelines for qualifications of your next Senior Pastor.

The only way we can establish who we are and where we are headed is if YOU are there.

In the meantime I would like you to pray that the Spirit of God will inspire you with ideas of where this congregation is being called and pray for the person that is being prepared to be your long term Senior Pastor.
